Design Considerations

- o Sealing and Flameproof Integrity: The spindle passes through the enclosure wall via a flameproof bushing or gland, which prevents sparks or hot gases from escaping .
- o Material Selection: Spindles are usually made from stainless steel or corrosion-resistant alloys to withstand harsh environments and maintain mechanical reliability .
- o Compatibility: The spindle must align with the internal mechanism, such as a breaker or switch, and may include gear reductions or couplings to facilitate smooth operation without excessive torque.
- o Maintenance: Regular inspection ensures that the spindle and its seals remain intact, preventing leaks that could compromise explosion protection .

Applications

Spindles are commonly used in:

- o Class I, Division 1 and 2 hazardous areas for oil, gas, and chemical plants .
- o Remote operation of breakers or disconnects where direct access is unsafe.
- o Integration with control panels that require mechanical actuation while maintaining enclosure integrity .
