

Standard for Galvanized Surface Thickness of Cable Trays

Article Overview

The galvanized zinc coating thickness for cable trays typically ranges from 45um to 65um depending on steel thickness and environmental requirements.

Standard Thickness Requirements

- o Tray Sheet Metal Thickness: Side and base plates of cable trays usually range from 1.5mm to 3mm. For these, the minimum local zinc thickness should be 45um, corresponding to a coating mass of at least 325 g/m². Heavier components like brackets and supports (>3mm) require ≥ 55 um zinc thickness .
- o Hot-Dip Galvanized Trays: For carbon steel trays, hot-dip galvanization per ASTM A123/A123M or equivalent standards is common. The average zinc coating thickness is typically 0.065 mm (65um) per side, equivalent to a coating weight of 460 g/m² .
- o Electro-Galvanized Trays: Electro-galvanized trays follow standards such as GB/T 26941.1-2011, with thickness requirements generally lower than hot-dip galvanization but sufficient for indoor or less corrosive environments .

Measurement and Quality

- o Local Thickness: Measured at multiple points using a magnetic thickness gauge; all points must meet the minimum requirement .
- o Mean Coating Mass: Determined gravimetrically over the entire workpiece to ensure uniform protection .
- o Appearance: The coating should be continuous, uniform, and smooth. Minor dull areas or water marks are acceptable, but defects like bare spots, blisters, or excessive zinc dross are not permitted .

Environmental Considerations

- o Outdoor or highly corrosive environments require hot-dip galvanization for maximum protection .
 - o Pre-galvanized or electro-galvanized trays are suitable for indoor or controlled environments .
 - o Damaged areas should be repaired with compatible zinc-rich compounds to maintain corrosion resistance .
- In summary, cable tray zinc coating thickness varies with material thickness, galvanization method, and environmental exposure, with typical values ranging from 45um for standard trays to 65um for heavy-duty or outdoor applications. Proper measurement and repair ensure long-term corrosion protection.

Regular checks on the thickness, uniformity, and adhesion of the zinc coating ensure that the hot-dip galvanize cable
