

Standard for Trough-type Fire-resistant Cable Trays

The National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) Standard VE 1-2002 provides guidance for metal cable trays and associated fittings designed for use in accordance with the rules of the NEC. The fire rating of slot-type fire-resistant Cable Trays is primarily determined by their fire endurance (the time during which the structure and electrical circuit remain intact under standard flame conditions).
