Solid Blue Light

A solid blue light on a fiber optic router typically means that the device is operating normally and has an active internet connection through the WAN or fiber port. Flashing Blue Light

If the blue light is flashing, it usually indicates data activity or that the router is booting up. Slow, steady blinking often occurs during startup, firmware updates, or network synchronization, while rapid blinking generally reflects active data transfer between the router and connected devices or the internet .

Troubleshooting Tips

- o Check connections: Ensure the fiber cable is securely connected to the router and the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) if applicable .
- o Power cycle: If the light remains flashing for an unusually long time, try restarting the router to reset the connection .
- o Inspect for issues: A blue light that does not turn solid after startup may indicate a configuration problem or a temporary service disruption from your ISP .
- o Contact support: If the light continues to behave abnormally despite checking connections and restarting, contact your ISP or router manufacturer for assistance . Understanding the blue light helps you quickly assess whether your fiber optic connection is functioning properly and whether any action is needed to restore or optimize your internet service.
