The Tonga Optical Cable Connector Package refers to the fiber-optic connectors and related components used in the Tonga Cable System, which links Tonga to Fiji and international networks.

Overview of the Tonga Cable System

The Tonga Cable System is an 827 km submarine fiber-optic network connecting Nukuʻalofa, Tonga to Suva, Fiji, where it links to the Southern Cross Cable Network . Commissioned in 2013 and managed by Tonga Cable Limited (TCL), the system was funded by the Asian Development Bank and the World Bank . It has landing points at Sopo, Tonga, and Suva, Fiji, with extensions to Haʻapai and Vavaʻu commissioned in 2018 . The system has experienced disruptions due to natural events, including volcanic eruptions, requiring specialized repair operations .

Optical Cable Connectors and Components

- o Fiber-optic connectors: High-precision connectors for splicing and terminating optical fibers, ensuring minimal signal loss.
