In a box plot, "W" typically represents the "whiskers," which extend from the box to the minimum and maximum values within 1.5 times the interquartile range, showing the spread of most of the data.

Understanding the Box Plot Components

A box plot is a graphical representation of a dataset based on its five-number summary: minimum, first quartile (Q1), median (Q2), third quartile (Q3), and maximum. The main components include:

- o Box: Extends from Q1 to Q3, representing the middle 50% of the data (interquartile range, IQR) and showing where most values lie .
- o Median Line: A line inside the box indicates the median (Q2), dividing the dataset into two equal halves .
- o Whiskers (W): Lines extending from the box to the smallest and largest values within $1.5 \times \text{IQR}$ from Q1 and Q3. They illustrate the range of most of the data and help identify potential outliers .
- o Outliers: Data points beyond the whiskers are plotted individually to highlight extreme values .

Role of Whiskers ("W")

The whiskers provide a visual cue for the spread and variability of the dataset. The left whisker extends from Q1 to the minimum value within the acceptable range, and the right whisker extends from Q3 to the maximum value within the acceptable range. Any points outside this range are considered outliers and are plotted separately .
