

What are the dimensions of a factory electrical distribution box

These boxes include busbars and droppers with cross-sections ranging from 50x8 mm to 1120x50x15 mm, and doors with overlapping collars and IP33-IP67 protection . Dimensions are often customized to meet project requirements, including depth for cable bending radius, heat dissipation, and future expansion .

Design Considerations

- o Internal Layout: Always consider the back-panel or mounting plate size, not just external dimensions, for proper placement of breakers, PLCs, or other devices .
- o Depth: Deeper boxes allow for more wiring capacity and easier maintenance .
- o Protection Rating: IP44 to IP67 ratings affect enclosure thickness and sealing, impacting overall dimensions .
- o Future-Proofing: Industrial boxes often include extra space for additional circuits, EV chargers, or smart system upgrades .
