The National Electrical Code establishes specific minimum distances when communications cables must run near power and light circuits. Industry standards such as ANSI/TIA-568 and ISO/IEC 11801 provide the following guidelines: Unshielded Power Cables: 50 mm (2 inches) for up to 2 kVA power cables.
