DSFP (Dual Small Form-Factor Pluggable) is an optical transceiver form factor introduced by the DSFP MSA in September 2018. It is designed to double the port density of traditional SFP modules while keeping the same mechanical dimensions, enabling higher bandwidth within the familiar SFP footprint.
