

What is a suitable module length in Singapore

Prefabricated MEP Modules

Modular Building Construction

In modular building construction, the length of modules is influenced by transportation limits, site access, and structural stability. Typically, modules can be designed up to 12 meters in length, which is considered practical for most construction sites in Singapore. Longer modules may require additional bracing or special transport arrangements. The framework often uses steel C-sections or hollow sections, and modules can be placed side by side to create larger open-plan spaces, such as in hospitals or schools .
