Managed switches and modular routers can range from several thousand to tens of thousands of dollars depending on port density and capabilities.

Moderate-Cost Components

Power Distribution Units (PDUs) and Uninterruptible Power Supplies (UPS) While essential for uptime and safety, PDUs and UPS systems are generally less expensive than servers or storage arrays. High-capacity or intelligent PDUs with monitoring features can cost hundreds to a few thousand dollars.

Cooling Systems Rack-mounted fans, airflow panels, and in-row cooling solutions are necessary for maintaining optimal temperatures. Advanced liquid cooling or high-density airflow management can increase costs but typically remain below the price of servers or storage arrays.

Lower-Cost Components

Patch Panels, Cable Management, Shelves, and Mounting Hardware These items are critical for organization and maintenance but are relatively inexpensive. Standard patch panels, cable organizers, and fixed shelves usually cost tens to a few hundred dollars per unit.
