

What size fiber distribution box should be used

Select a fiber distribution box with sufficient ports for current needs plus 20-30% extra capacity for future expansion.

Key Considerations for Sizing

Port Capacity: Fiber distribution boxes are available in configurations supporting 8 to 96 fiber ports or more. The number of ports should match your current network requirements while leaving 20-30% headroom to accommodate future growth without immediate replacement . **Application Type:** Determine whether the FDB is for FTTH, FTTB, or campus PON deployments. Indoor compact boxes are suitable for limited space, while outdoor boxes require higher durability and environmental protection . **Splice and Termination Needs:** Ensure the box has enough splice trays, adapters, and slack storage to manage all incoming and outgoing fibers. Boxes should allow easy access for maintenance and maintain the safe bend radius for fibers . **Material and Environmental Protection:** Indoor boxes can use ABS or engineering plastics, while outdoor boxes benefit from SMC or ABS+PC for UV and impact resistance. Check the IP rating to ensure protection against dust and water, especially for outdoor or high-humidity installations . **Future Scalability:** Consider boxes that allow modular expansion, such as additional splitter modules or patch panels, to avoid costly replacements as the network grows . **Mounting and Accessibility:** Ensure the box can be securely mounted and provides front-side access for installation and maintenance. Doors should open widely (e.g., >120°) and lock securely .

Practical Recommendation

For a typical FTTH deployment, a 16-32 port FDB is often sufficient for small buildings or residential clusters, while 48-96 port boxes are recommended for larger multi-dwelling units or high-density areas. Always plan for extra capacity to accommodate future subscribers or network upgrades . By considering port capacity, environmental protection, material durability, and future scalability, you can select a fiber distribution box that ensures reliable performance, simplifies maintenance, and supports network growth.
