

What to pay attention to when installing cable trays cable racks

Supports and Fixing

Ensure stable and properly spaced supports to prevent sagging or deformation. Supports should be securely fixed to structural elements, and the tray should be level and aligned. The support span must match the tray's load capacity to avoid bending or fracture . Additional support points may be required for heavy cable loads.

Cable Management

Ladder trays provide better ventilation for large cables, while ventilated troughs offer continuous support for smaller or sensitive cables . Follow safety protocols, including PPE, Lockout/Tagout (LOTO), and hot work permits if required . Ensure installation meets international standards such as IEC 60364, IEEE, and IEC 60079 for hazardous locations . Handle cables carefully to avoid impact or compression damage during installation .

After installation, inspect trays for alignment, deformation, and secure fixing. Regularly monitor load capacity and cable condition to maintain safety and reliability . Adjust and correct any deviations to meet design requirements.
