

# What tools are used to make cable tray bends

They can handle larger cross-sections (35-500 mm<sup>2</sup>) and offer adjustable angles from 0° to 180°. These tools are constructed from corrosion-resistant alloys and feature polished guides to prevent scratches, making them suitable for professional and industrial applications.

### Automated Cable Tray Bending Machines

For large-scale or manufacturing applications, automated cable tray bending machines offer high-speed, precise, and repeatable bends. These machines can handle various types of trays, including perforated and ladder trays, and allow batch settings for length, quantity, and angle. They are CE and ISO certified, ensuring compliance with industrial standards, and are ideal for reducing labor costs while maintaining consistent quality.

- o **Choose the Right Tool:** Select a bender appropriate for the tray size and material. Manual benders are suitable for small jobs, hydraulic for medium to large trays, and automated machines for production-scale work.
- o **Bend Gradually:** Apply force slowly to avoid deforming or cracking the tray. For manual methods, use

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leverage points or crimping techniques to achieve smooth bends . By selecting the appropriate tool and following proper preparation steps, cable tray bends can be made efficiently and safely, whether on-site or in a production environment.
