- o Covers: Solid or ventilated covers protect cables from dust, debris, and accidental damage while maintaining signal reliability .
- o Separation from power cables: Use dividers or separate trays to prevent electrical noise from affecting alarm signals .
- o Tray fill: Follow the 40% fill rule to avoid overcrowding, which can cause overheating or mechanical stress .
- o Expansion joints: For long runs, include expansion joints every 30 meters to accommodate thermal expansion and prevent tray deformation .

Compliance and Safety

Ensure that the tray system and installation comply with UL 2196 or EN 1363-1 standards for fire alarm systems. Properly rated trays, bolts, and brackets are critical to maintain system functionality during emergencies .
