Sales Channels and Packaging

Optical modules, including transceivers, amplifiers, and splitters, are generally sold as individual units that plug into switches, routers, servers, or storage devices for high-speed data transmission . They are also sold in bulk to data centers, telecom operators, and enterprise customers, often as part of large-scale network infrastructure deployments . Pricing for new modules typically ranges from \$150 to \$200 per unit, though high-speed modules like 400G, 800G, and 1.6T can command higher prices due to performance and bandwidth requirements .

OEM and Distributor Channels

Many optical modules are sold through original equipment manufacturers (OEMs) or authorized distributors. OEM sales often involve customized modules designed for specific network equipment, while distributors provide standardized modules for broader market use. Leading Chinese vendors and international system OEMs dominate the supply chain, particularly for high-speed modules used in AI and cloud data centers .

Secondary Market for Used Modules

There is a growing resale market for used optical modules, driven by data centers and enterprises upgrading to higher-speed modules (e.g., from 10G to 400G). Modules that are still functional but no longer meet the latest performance requirements are sold for budget-constrained or low-speed applications, such as internal monitoring or backup links . This secondary market is analogous to the used mobile phone market, where relatively new devices are resold to extend their lifecycle and optimize costs .

Trends Affecting Sales

- o High-speed demand: Modules for 400G/800G and 1.6T are increasingly sold to support AI clusters and hyperscale cloud infrastructure .
- o Bulk procurement: Large-scale data centers often purchase modules in volume contracts to meet network expansion needs .
- o Supply chain diversification: Vendors qualify multiple suppliers to ensure availability, affecting how modules are packaged and sold .
