

Which port on the router is the fiber optic port

Article Overview

Fiber optic internet connects to your router via an ONT, which then links to the router's WAN or SFP port.

Understanding the Connection

Fiber optic internet typically does not plug directly into a standard router. Instead, your Internet Service Provider (ISP) installs an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the optical signal from the fiber cable into an electrical signal that your router can use . The fiber optic cable from the wall outlet connects directly to the ONT's designated fiber port, often labeled "Fiber" or "GPON" .

Router Port for Fiber

Once the ONT converts the signal, you connect it to your router using an Ethernet cable. The correct port on the router is usually the WAN port (sometimes labeled "Internet") or, for routers with fiber support, an SFP port designed for fiber modules . This port is typically color-coded or labeled differently from LAN ports to distinguish it from local network connections .

Key Points:

- o WAN Port: Standard routers use this port to receive internet from the ONT via Ethernet.
- o SFP Port: Some high-end or fiber-ready routers allow direct fiber modules to plug in, bypassing the Ethernet conversion.
- o Labels: Look for markings like "WAN," "Internet," "ONT," or "Fiber" on the router to identify the correct port .

Setup Summary

- o Fiber cable from ISP -> ONT fiber port.
- o ONT Ethernet port -> Router WAN port (or SFP if supported).
- o Power on ONT and router.
- o Configure router settings if required (ISP credentials, VLAN tagging, etc.), .
- o Connect devices via Wi-Fi or LAN ports for internet access. By following this setup, your router will properly receive the fiber optic internet signal and distribute it to your devices.
